Latent Tubercular Miasm

- Irritable , tanciturn, sullen and critical of everybody around him and his conditions.
- Constant desire for change, wanting to go somewhere or do something different.
- Although illness is hopeless he still thinks he will get better
- Mentals > nose bleed
- Children- Difficult, fretful, whining, obstinate, fits of temper if approached for medical exam or anything they do not like.Cries out in sleep
- Problem child in school. Unsocial, slow comprehension, dull unable to keep his line of thoughts, keeps to himself, morose and sullen.

Dr Vijaykar's concepts of miasms

- Miasms compare favourably with the inflammatory pathology of the disease itself.
- Psora pathology compares with the irritability and sensitivity of Psoric mind
- Hidden disease and growth of Sycosis pathology compares with the hiding and multiplying of Sycosis mind.
- Destructive and distorted syphilis pathology compares with destructive and perverted Syphilis mentality

Tubercular miasm- Vijaykar

- Tubercular disease has three stages
 - Inflammation of pleura/lungs at the onset
 - Tubercle formation in the lungs
 - Cavitation in lungs
- Physiological and inflammatory, Psoric in stage 1, constructive and sycotic in stage 2, destructive and syphilitic in stage 3.
- So a combination of all 3 miasms.

Tubercular miasm- Sankaran

- In the pathology we see both destruction of tissues and a lasting debility in the form of restricted lung space eg due to fibrosis.
 - Sycotic aspect of situation is not totally lost but the patient lives for the rest of his life with a fixed weakness and recurrent tendencies to cold and respiratory probs.
 - Syphilitic aspect of violent progressive features which are hopeless without medical intervention eg TB meningitis etc.
- So between sycosis and syphillis.

- Sense of oppression, Physically- Oppression of chest and suffocation and a great need to take a deep breath..
- React with violence, desire for change, need to travel, boldness and daring.

Tubercular Personality - Sankaran

- May see the rules of society to be too oppressive, rigid, strict almost oppressive. Breaking free from the bonds of society. (dreams of being a prude and desire for change)
- Borderline of what is acceptable to society eg wild dare devil acts, seeking change and excitement.
- Bold rash personality which are at times destructive.
- Eg the youth of today versus the orthodox society(school, parents, church etc) –
- Eg - Situation in India – poor and destitute subjected to atrocities and reacts with violence, bringing about the desired change.
